Registration forms are available on line at this web site or you may pick up registration forms at the Schuyler County Chamber of Commerce, 1 Franklin Street in Watkins Glen. The final time to register your boat is Friday June 13th at Seneca Harbor Park at the headquarters tent next to the boat launch from 6p-9p. If you register early by email or fax we would still love to meet you on Friday night. Stop and pick up your tee shirts enjoy some live music, the Blessing of the Fleet and sample some taste temptations from our excellent food vendors

If you are participating in the “Moving Display of Cardboard Boats” the parade will leave 3rd Street and Franklin at Noon on Saturday. Street line up can begin after 11:00am. Watkins Glen Village Police will be closing 3rd Street to allow the boats to line up for the parade. Once 3rd street is full we will begin using 2nd Please do not park on Decatur Street or use the Villager Parking lot off of 3rd Street

When you reach Seneca Harbor Park, our Boat Parking KREW, in green vests, will direct your crew. If you are walking or have a small boat be will try to put you at the beginning of the parade and get you into the park ahead of the bigger boats on trailers. If you have a big boat and need special assistance with unloading and parking we will direct you to the area designated for unloading and parking. Very important...DO NOT STOP when you reach the parking area...proceed until you are directed to a designated parking area. If you stop to unload...everyone behind you must stop and as you can imagine this causes a large large problem. Please follow the Boat Parking KREW instructions so we can get everyone parked in a timely fashion.

As always we look forward to the event and to the wonderful and inventive boats you create.
